In February of 2000 Drs. Stephen and Rose Lemarie opened Southeast Veterinary Specialists in Metairie, Louisiana. Dr. Lemarie also sees referral cases in Gulfport, MS on a monthly basis. Dr. Lemarie is the past chairman of the ACVD research committee; reviews manuscripts for the Journal of the American Veterinary Medical Association and his areas of interest include allergic, fungal, parasitic and autoimmune skin diseases. In his spare time Dr. Lemarie enjoys water sports with his wife Rose, showing his Staffordshire Bull Terrier "Tasso" and training and competing in powerlifting.

Dr. Rose Lemarie is a board certified veterinary surgeon. She is a native of Little Rock, Arkansas, and completed her undergraduated education at the University of Louisiana at Monroe. Dr. Lemarie is a graduate of the Louisiana State University School of Veterinary Medicine. Following veterinary school, she completed her internship at the Virginia Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine followed by her residency training in surgery at LSU. Dr. Lemarie has been practicing at Southeast Veterinary specialists for 9 years. Her interests include all areas of orthopedic, neurologic, and general surgery, however her main interests are orthopedics and neurosurgery. Dr. Lemarie especially enjoys performing spinal surgery for intervertebral disk disease.

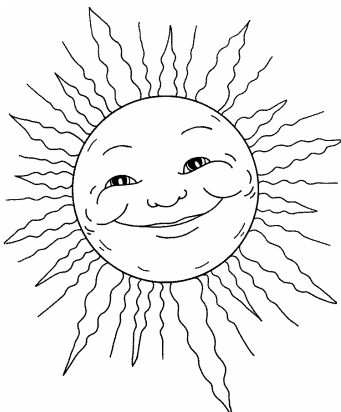
